Come enjoy chili & a bun at lunch and vote for the TSSA Executive member who cooked up the most rockin' pot of chili!

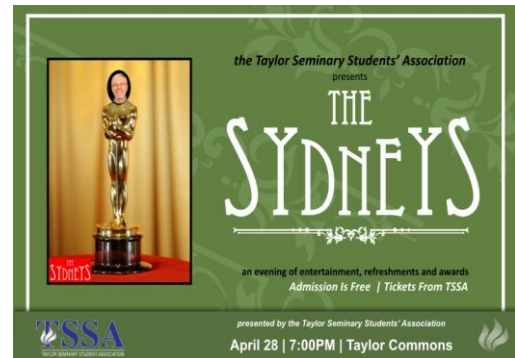
